A Session Devoted to Analyzing the Basic Meaning of the Text

Recommended Prerequisite: Familiarity with elementary Rabbinical-Hebrew vocabulary.

A conversation in parsing the sedrah of the week, examining the text from the perspective of the classic Torah commentators mainly Rashi, also Rashbam and Ibn Ezra. Main focus is Rashi comments as expounded by supercommentaries Sifsei Chachamim and Mizrachi.
